We have recently updated and expanded our education programme with new and exciting activities. Our aim is to engage the children in Lincolnshire's local aviation heritage.

The children will belong to a Bomber Squadron whilst they are here, imagine being a war-time evacuee and, if they wish to, eat their lunch in the 1940's Gymnasium, laid out as if invited to a street party.



Choose from a range of activities for example:

- Discover more about RAF Metheringham's history, and 106 Squadron of RAF Bomber Command;

- Learn about the roles of the aircrew who flew the RAF's famous Avro Lancaster bombers from this airfield;



- Find out about FIDO (Fog Investigation and Dispersal Operation), a unique World War Two invention installed at RAF Metheringham to help aircraft land in foggy weather;

- Experience an air raid in the airfield's original war-time blast and air-raid shelters;



- Have a lesson in our World War Two vintage Douglas Dakota transport aircraft. Learn about the role of this aircraft and the part it played at RAF Metheringham;

- Be a wartime detective and investigate our original war-time objects
